

HOW NGN DIFFERS FROM THE CURRENT NCLEX

In 2023, students will be tested on a new version of the NCLEX. NCSBN is still finalizing details, but here are some for-sure facts.

WHAT WON'T CHANGE

- The exam will continue to measure the same critical content areas.
- Most items on the minimum-length exam will be standard NCLEX items.
- The scoring scale will not change.
- The exam will remain computer-adaptive.

WHAT WILL CHANGE

- Each candidate will see a set amount of case studies.
- The test will use partial-credit scoring.
- Students may also receive single, standalone, clinical judgment item types called bowties.
