HOW TO REPLACE A CLINICAL DAY

IN THE VIRTUAL CLASSROOM

USING REAL LIFE CLINICAL REASONING SCENARIOS

STEP 1: REVIEW PREPARED LESSON PLAN

Your clinical day lesson plans include:

- Necessary materials
- Lesson objectives
- Time required for completion
- An overview of each scenario
- Instructional components

STEP 2: REVIEW LESSON PLAN WITH STUDENTS & ASSIGN PREWORK

- Explain the objectives
- Detail time needed for completion
- Describe the scenario
- Identify deliverables.

STEP 3A:

HAVE STUDENTS WATCH THE SCENARIO INDEPENDENTLY

After students finish:

- Ask them to review their results and identify knowledge gaps
- Have them go through again
- Break into small groups
- Ask them "What if ...?" questions.

STEP 3B:

HAVE STUDENTS WATCH THE SCENARIO AS A GROUP

- Turn off "Optimal Decisions Highlighted Mode"
- Pause video when it's time to make a decision
- Ask students to describe their decisions — especially incorrect ones
- Ask "What if ...?" questions

STEP 4: REFLECT & DEBRIEF

Students should review their individual score reports and SBAR score reports. Then, assign students to:

- Review and reflect on how they performed
- Fulfill additional assignments suggested in the lesson plan
- Remediate by answering questions such as:
 - > What did you learn?
 - > What part of the experience will help you make better decisions in the future?
